Board members were provided with updates on the status of the new website interaction and how successful the billing is working with Edmunds and PayArgo, they were also provided with an update and demonstration on the current Vepo Crossconnex testing site.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

Solicitor Miller presented the Board with the TOA Phase 1 & 2 Easement Agreement and recommended the Board approve and have executed and recorded. There being no other discussion, Motion by Member Fogliani, Seconded by Member Baldauf. Motion carried.

Solicitor Miller discussed the status of the Dedication Agreement that is needed next for Phase 1 & 2. After some discussion, the Board requested the Dedication be drafted and sent to the Developer for signature.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Dave Coldren reported Bakerstown Road Waterlne Extension is complete and the Authority is still withholding \$5,000 in retainage from JS Bova for springtime restoration that should begin within the next month. Mr Coldren also updated the Board on the status of Carl and Betty Lane by CRS Construction who has completed the main line work.

Mr Coldren confirmed the Authority received the second payment request from CRS for work completed on Carl and Betty Lane and recommended approval. After some discussion, Motion by Member Fogliani, Seconded by Member Anderson to authorize payment in the amount of \$119,861.56 to CRS as recommended. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

KLH provided an updated tap fee report to the Authority as requested. The tap fee study included additional work that has been completed over the last decade to justify the added costs. After some discussion, Motion made by Member Fogliani, Seconded by Member Baldauf to approve Resolution 2-2023 approving the tap study, new tap rates, timeline for existing tap rates to be expired for certain areas of the service area, establishing a new 2 year term for taps to be made after payment and setting a renewal fee for taps that have not been made. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board was presented with a request by the Richland Township Manager to cost share in the relocation of the waterline along Rt 910 at Community Center Drive. Costs to be borne by the Authority included the waterline design and inspection costs and PennDOT HOP permit costs. After some discussion, Motion by Member Fogliani, Seconded by Member Baldauf approving the request. Motion carried.

The Board had authorized McMorran Rd waterline replacement as a base bid with two alternates. The project was duly advertised and bids received and opened through PennBid on 3/13/23 at 10 am. The apparent low bidder was Protocol for the base bid amount of \$185,325 and alternate 1 amount of \$139,635, the combined total of the base bid and Alternate 1 are \$324,960. After some discussion, Motion by Member Anderson, Seconded by Member Fogliani to approve the base bid and alternate 1 to the apparent low bidder, Protocol in the amount of \$324,960 pending the background review of KLH. Motion carried.

There being no more business Motion made by Member Anderson and seconded by Member Baldauf to adjourn the meeting at 7:35 PM. Motion carried with Member Fogliani dissenting.
